- 1 My speech, the ear of the LORD,  
Consider my groaning.
- 2 Pay attention to the sound of my cry,  
My king and my God,  
For to you I will direct my prayer.
- 3 O LORD, in the morning,  
You will hear my voice.  
In the morning, I will set it in order before you,  
And I will watch.
- 4 For you do not take pleasure in wickedness,  
Evil does not abide with you.
- 5 The foolish will not stand,  
Before your eyes,  
You hate all the workers of iniquity.
- 6 You destroy the words of falsehood,  
A bloody man and deceitful,  
He will be abhorred, O LORD.
- 7 But I, in the abundance of your mercy,  
I will enter your house,  
I will worship before your holy temple,  
In your fear.
- 8 O LORD, lead me in your righteousness,  
Because of my enemies,  
Make straight before me your way.
- 9 For there is nothing reliable in his mouth,  
Their inward parts are profane,  
Their throat is an open grave,  
Their tongue flatters.

- 10 God will declare them guilty so that they fall,  
From their plans.  
In the multitude of their transgressions thrust them out,  
For they have rebelled against you.
- 11 So then all those who seek refuge will rejoice in you,  
Forever will they lift up their praise.  
And you will defend them, and they will rejoice in you,  
Those who love your name.
