- 1 The heavens recount the glory of God,

- 2 Day to day bubbles up speech,

- 3 There is no speech and there are no words,  
Without their voice being heard.
- 4 In all the earth, their line goes forth,  
And so, they fill it to the end of the world.

- 5 And he, like a bridegroom, comes forth from his chamber,  
He rejoices like a mighty man to run his course.
- 6 From one end of heavens to the other,  
And his circuit unto their end,

- 7 The law of the Lord is perfect,  
Converting the soul.  
The testimonies of the LORD are sure,  
Making wise the simple.
- 8 The precepts of the LORD are upright,
